## **TECH TIP CORNER**

When hitting the trails, adjusting your tire pressure can make or break your off-road experience. Airing down increases your tires' contact patch, giving you a better grip on rocks, sand, and mud while providing a smoother ride over rough terrain. For instance, dropping your pressure from 30 psi to 20 psi can expand your contact area by almost 24%, and going down to 12 psi can boost it by a whopping 59%. This added traction helps your tires conform to obstacles, keeping you in control when the going gets tough. Just don't forget to air back up before returning to the pavement to ensure safe handling and protect your tires from unnecessary wear.
